Importance of CPR

There is no way to teach you everything you need to know about injury prevention and first aid in this 6-hour course. I strongly encourage you to receive additional training and certification in first aid and CPR (Cardio-pulmonary Resuscitation). This course **will in NO way take the place of a formal CPR course**. It is very important to successfully complete a course in CPR through an accredited course provider. CPR can save a child's life in the necessary situation. Be sure that you take a course that is geared for those who care for children. Training resources can be found in your participant handbook.
