

EMSIRS-3 Vendor Status

If you use a software package to collect your EMSIRS data, your vendor will need to be compliant with EMSIRS-3 or with NEMSIS 3.4 data standards. Below is a listing of vendors that have clients in Ohio and their status with reporting to EMSIRS-3:

There are two methods of data submission from a software package to EMSIRS, one is manual file upload, the other is automatic file submission. Your vendor will be able to tell you which method to use.

If Your Vendor Is Not On The List Above, Is On The Not Testing List or Is Discontinuing

You need to contact your vendor *as soon as possible* to determine their status. If the vendor is not working towards EMSIRS-3 compliance or if you are unsatisfied with their response, contact the EMS Office of Research and Analysis at EMSdata@dps.ohio.gov and we will be happy to send you the contact information for the compliant vendors.
