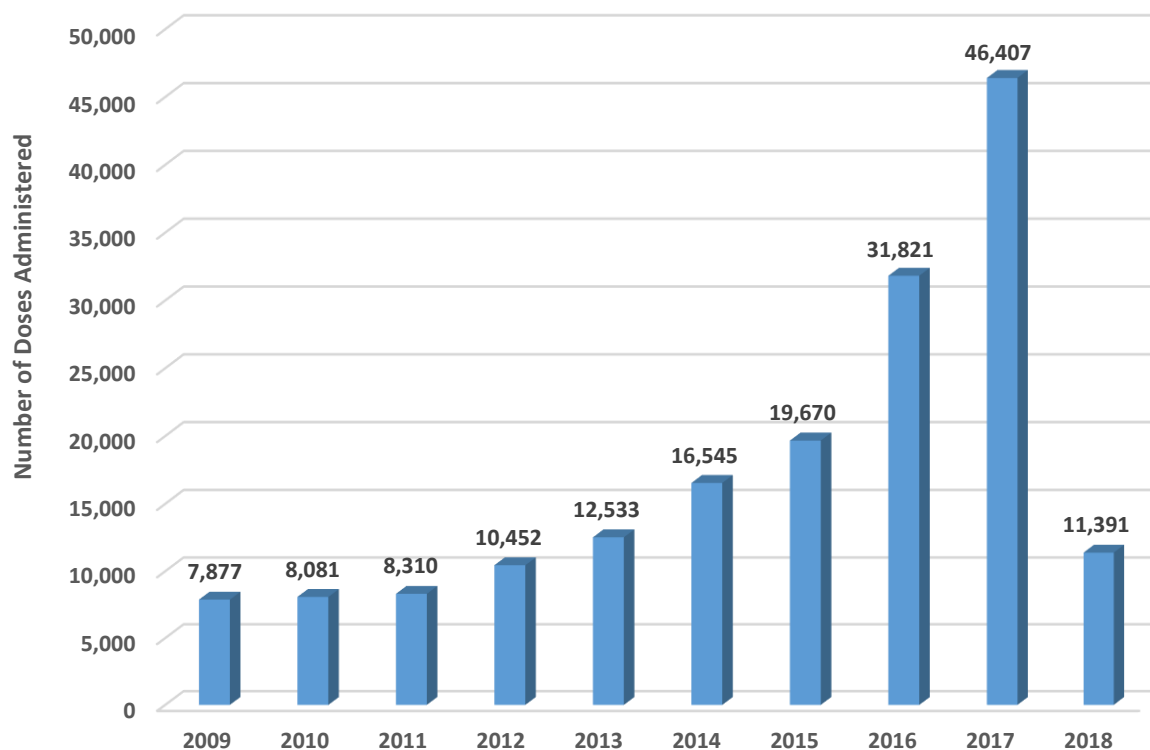


Naloxone Administration by Ohio EMS Providers, 2009-2018^{1,2,3,4,5,6} Summary Brief as June 11, 2018

³ The data includes naloxone administrations where county was not recorded (blank/unknown) n=140 (2016), n=73 (2017) and n=27 (2018).

⁴ Naloxone doses administered in out of state ZIP codes are excluded.

⁵ As of June 11, 2018, 769 of the 1,055 known transporting EMS agencies (72.9%) in 2017 reported through EMSIRS; the 1,055 agency count is prior to agency mergers that have taken place in 2018.

⁶ As of June 11, 2018, 763 of the 1,059 known transporting EMS agencies (72%) in 2018 reported through EMSIRS. The accuracy of data reported to EMSIRS is limited by the number of individual EMS agencies submitting data and the accuracy of these submissions.
