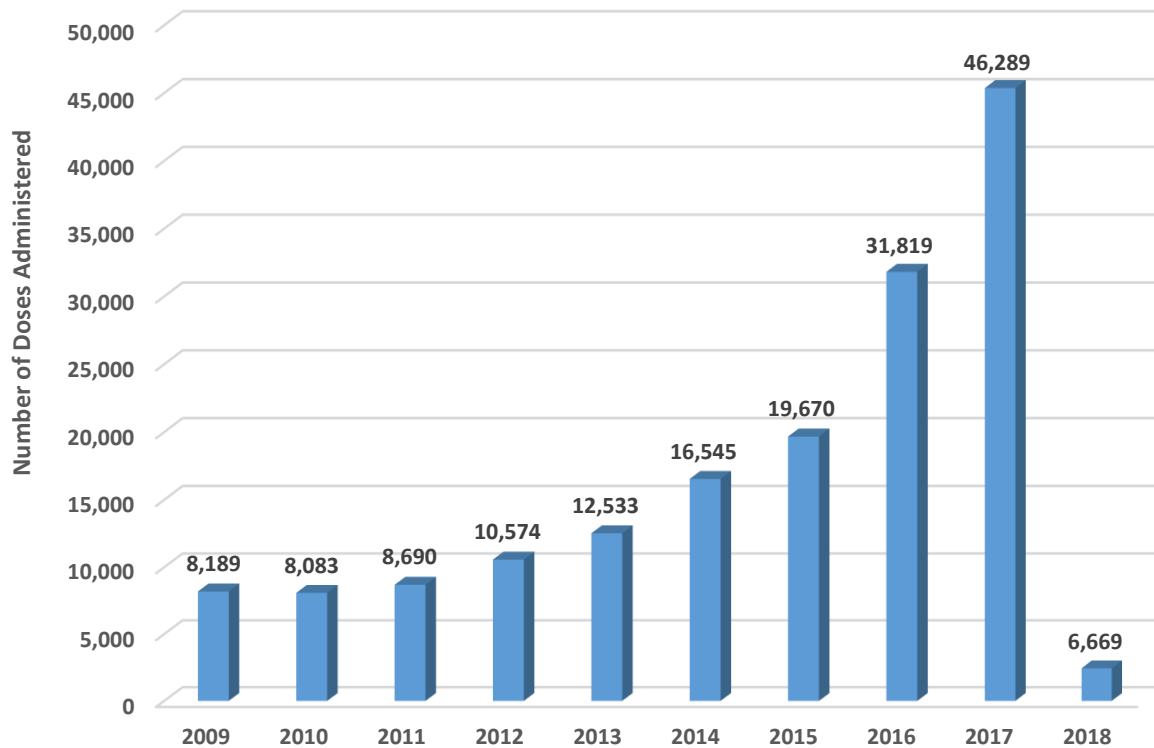


Naloxone Administration by Ohio EMS Providers, 2009-2018 ^{1,2,3,4,5} Summary Brief as April 16, 2018

⁵ As of April 16, 2018, 713 of the 1,058 known transporting EMS agencies (67.4%) in 2018 reported through EMSIRS.
