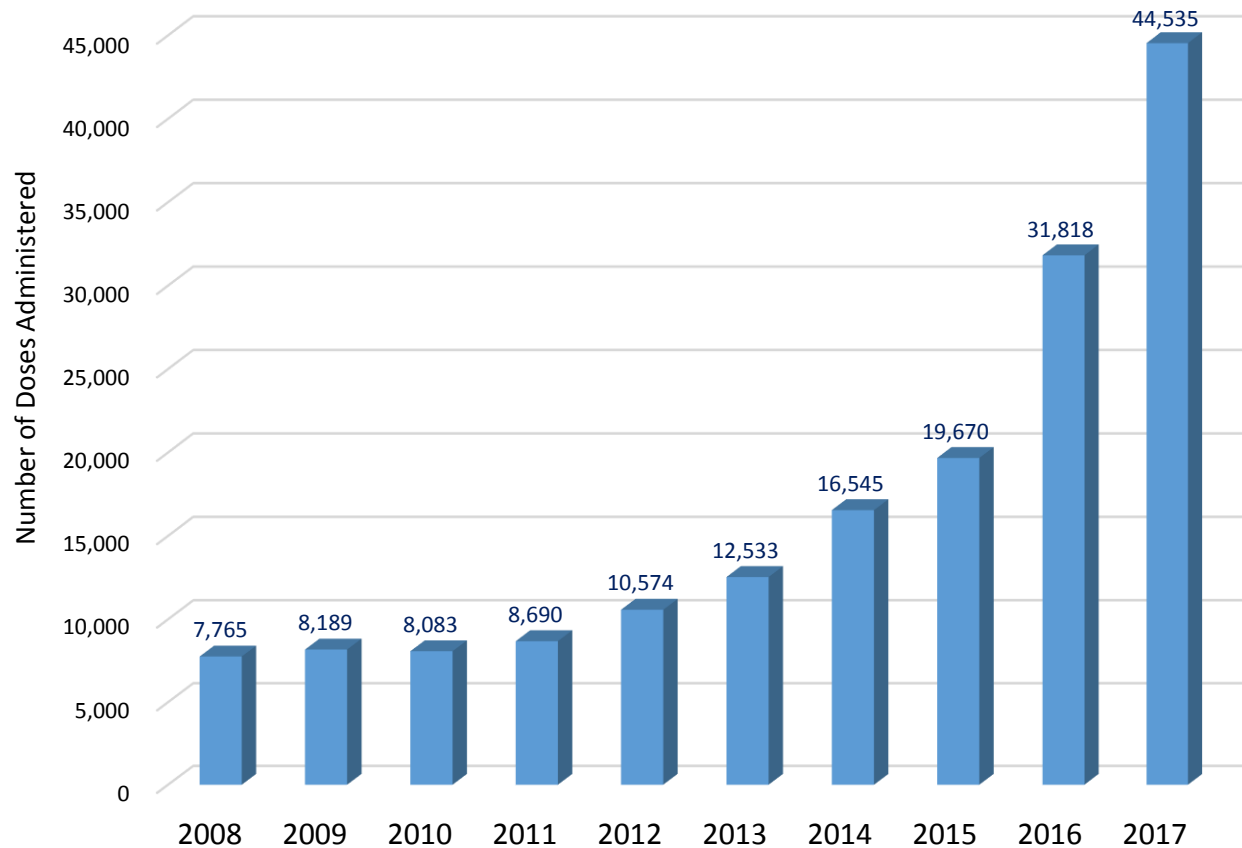


# Naloxone Administration by Ohio EMS Providers, 2008-2017 <sup>1,2,3</sup>

## Summary Brief as of January 16, 2018

The accuracy of data reported to EMSIRS is limited by the number of individual EMS agencies submitting data and the accuracy of these submissions. As of January 16, 2018, 760 of the 1056 transporting EMS agencies (72%) reported through EMSIRS.
