On June 30, 2021, Governor DeWine signed HB 110 which included the following provision:

## **SECTION 747.20.**

**During the period beginning on the effective date of this section and ending October 1, 2022, and notwithstanding any conflicting provision of the Revised Code, a first responder, emergency medical technician-basic, emergency medical technician-intermediate, and emergency medical technician-paramedic may perform emergency medical services in any setting, including in any area of a hospital, if the services performed under the direction and supervision of one of the following:**

- (1) A physician;**
- (2) A physician assistant designated by a physician;**
- (3) An advanced practice registered nurse designated by a physician.**

This provision supersedes **Ohio Revised Code 4765.36 Authorized services in hospital** through October 1, 2022, and enables all Emergency Medical Services (EMS) providers to perform emergency medical services in any setting. This includes any area of a hospital, if the services are performed under the direction and supervision of either a physician, a physician assistant designated by a physician, or an advanced practice registered nurse designated by a physician.
