DISCUSSION	Dr. Stanley noted that the Pediatric Emergency Fellows Conference went well with 26 fellows attending the meeting on September 29 th . Dr. Stanley added that the topics for this year's conference were simulation training, employment contracts, difficult conversations, and the history of EMSC.
	Mr. Stack reminded everyone to complete the Committee Application form and to submit it with a copy of their resumé before the December meeting.
	Dr. Julie Leonard stated that she would challenge the ethics rules regarding committee members being precluded from receiving state grants for their field projects noting that this is a disincentive for serving on committees.
	Mr. Stack announced that the EMS Survey starts November 1 st , and that the list of agencies selected would be emailed to everyone on the Committee when available. Mr. Stack added that the survey will close January 31, 2018.
	Ms. Wedding stated she would like to look into Ohio having a rare disease advisory council which has a potential to facilitate legislation and create support for families of children who have been diagnosed with rare diseases. Dr. Dahl-Grove stated that Ohio AAP would be the best avenue to pitch the formation of the committee.
	Dr. Leonard made a motion to adjourn; Ms. Wedding seconded. Meeting adjourned at 12:43pm.
