Welcome and Introduction – Convened at 1:12 p.m.

Approval of Minutes - August 14, 2018 – No quorum at October 16th meeting/notes only

ACTION: Motion to approve the Critical Care Sub-Committee Meeting minutes from August 14, 2018. Mr. Martin – First. Ms. Hines– Second. None opposed. None abstained. Motion approved.

Proposed New Committee Members: Jason Waltmire and Ryan Sullivan

Ms. Rose gave brief bios of both applicants. The committee agreed to add both members. Therefore, Ms. Rose will present to the Board for approval.

Review / Discuss Revised Air Medical Rules and Equipment / Supply Checklist:

- **Review Supply Checklist:** Several changes made.
 1. Section A. Aircraft – **add** .04 – Survival Kit
 2. Section C. Airway Equipment .01, .02, & .03 remove “Complete set of “
 3. Section C. Airway Equipment
 4. Section C. Airway Equipment - .19 **remove**
 5. Section G. Oxygen Equipment – **Change to read:** Medical Gas & Equipment
 6. Section G. “ “ - .01 Main oxygen (M tank or ~~equivalent~~) – equivalent changed to greater (Current hydrostatic testing) if applicable

7. Section G. .03 **add** (1)
8. Section I. Intravenous Equipment – move 0.11 to section A, #.04
Delete .06 and make .09 & .010 move up to .08 & .09

- **Should aircraft pay a one-time fee for temporary aircraft?**

Currently, aircraft renewals include a temporary permit log. The proposal is to have aircraft pay the same fee as ambulance services. Ambulance services pay \$100.00 per permit and is good for 60-days. The service would complete a temporary ambulance form and fax the form to Medical Transportation (MT). MT signs the form, and applies the 60-day date-of-expiration then faxes the form back to the service the same day. A lengthy discussion ensued and the decision is to modify the ambulance temporary permit form to satisfy the aircraft requirements, Mr. Fiffick will draft the new form and present it at the next meeting.

- **Satellites – Locations (unresolved issue)**

A lengthy discussion ensued. Currently, Medical Transportation (MT) inspectors are inspecting satellites out-of-state. Some questions raised to consider asking other state to send their records of inspection to MT.

Ms. Rose – Next step is to look at other states standards; we may consider reciprocity.

Critical Care Paramedic Certification / Endorsement: Continue Discussion

- **Review committee finding IBSC Certification and the requirements for Critical Care Paramedic and Flight Paramedic**

Ms. Rose - To the committee; be thinking about how to draft language for qualifications and how to maintain certification as critical care paramedic / endorsement.
