Welcome and Introduction

Dr. Hamilton Schwartz, Chair, began meeting at 11:05 am.

Approval of Minutes

Agenda Item: Prehospital PECC Program Update – Joe Stack

Mr. Stack updated the Committee on activities under the PECC Learning Collaborative grant. Mr. Stack noted that several conference calls had been held with the EIIC, and that the state team had also held a conference call to begin work on the project, focusing on communication with target agencies and planning for the in-person meeting January 31-February 1 in Austin, TX.

Agenda Item: Pediatric Prehospital Guidelines Discussion – Dr. Schwartz

Dr. Schwartz stated that he needs to have the final draft of the guidelines from everyone as soon as possible so that he can get the formatting completed by February. Discussion was held about the formatting. Dr. Cunningham addressed the guidelines and algorithms and gave guidance to the committee on how to approach writing the guidelines.

Agenda Item: Ohio Pediatric Disaster Preparedness Coalition Update – Dr. Dahl-Grove/ Viola Webber

The Coalition is working on encouraging PECCs in community hospitals. Dr. Dahl-Grove reported that the Coalition would be under ODH guidance in the future, and that they were planning to share the ESI pediatric triage module to community hospital ED staff as a training and/or QI project. Ms. Webber noted that the 2016 survey would be repeated to verify gaps in care.

Agenda Item: Child Maltreatment Training Update – Mr. Joe Stack

Mr. Stack reported that the first training module is now live on the Public Safety Training Campus and approved for 1 hour of continuing education. Dr. Leonard added that there would be more modules in the future.

ACTION: Joe will find out if each module will need Board approval for CE.

Agenda Item: EMFTS Board Strategic Plan – Dr. Dahl Grove, Tami Wires

Mr. Stack reported that the Committee is working on the same topics that the Medical Oversight Committee is working on, and that Dr. Dahl-Grove and Ms. Wires could be the liaisons with that committee to ensure pediatric issues are included in their plans.

Mr. Stack reviewed the attendance policy and went over the attendance records for the year, and added that there are currently two vacancies, and that representation from ACEP and ENA as organizations, and Toledo Children's Hospital, are still sought.
